The manikin can be used for realistic training of external chest compressions and the placement of AED pads, in order to get used in the handling of AED's. The unique hygienic system prevents cross contamination when demonstrating and training of the principals of ventilation through mouth and nose.

The Ambu Man School is intended to be used for education of pupils in schools under the supervision of an instructor/teacher.
