#### **Rx DESTROYER™ Directions**

- 1. Load medications into the bottle Use funnel for easy loading
  - Load patches into bottle
  - Squirt syringe dose into bottle
  - DO NOT place syringe or vial into the bottle, use Sharps container
- 2. Tightly secure cap and gently shake for 10 seconds
- 3. Store in safe area and use again
- 4. After each drug disposal session, repeat step #2
- 5. Bottle is full when contents rises within 2" from top of bottle
- 6. Discard full bottle in common garbage
  - Do not pour contents in a sink or flush in toilets
  - Funnel can be used again Do not discard

#### **OPTIONAL:**

Prior to discarding bottle, Hardener Packet(s) may be added to convert liquid contents to a solid. Help to prevent accidental liquid spills in garbage can.

Refer to instructions on Hardener Packet.

## Types of Non-Hazardous Medication

Pills, Liquids, Syringe Injectables, Fentanyl Patches, Suppositories, & Lozenges

- Medications will dissolve
- Activated carbon absorbs/neutralizes
- · Outer capsule shell and fentanyl patch material will remain intact
- Meets EPA and DNR solid non-hazardous waste guidelines (Refer to state and local hazardous waste disposal regulation)
